



TENBURY 33rd ANNUAL COLLECTIVE SALE OF STANDING STRAW

5th JULY 2018

Nick Champion reports an entry of 901.75 acres of standing straw was offered on Thursday 5th July 2017 at The Fountain Inn.

The long spell of hot dry weather together with a low carryover of stocks from last season has certainly bucked up demand.

Winter Wheat Straw was in very good demand although prices were determined by the quality and quantity of crop and the location. Winter Wheat topped at £88 per acre twice for 18 acres at Bickley House Farm, Bickley and for 18 acres at Stockwell Park, Stockton-on-Teme.

Winter Barley Straw sold to a top of £76 for 10.25 acres at Upper Hollin Farm, Pensax.

Spring Barley Straw sold to a top of £67 for 12.5 acres at Easton Farm, Little Hereford.

Winter Oat Straw sold to a top of £58 for 18 acres at High House Lane, Tedstone Wafre.

Spring Oat Straw sold to a top of £50 for two 6.5 acres fields at Burton Court, Upper Sapey.

Rape Haulm sold at a very creditable £42 for 27.5 acres at Woodhampton, Bleathwood.
