

Ripplewood Manor Farm Dispersal Sale – Friday 18th October 2019 – Sale Report

Despite the very wet weather, there was a large turnout of buyers at the farm dispersal sale held at Ripplewood Manor, Collington for Mr and Mrs Gordon Yardley and others.

Tractors: The 1992 John Deere 2850, in very good condition for its age, attracted considerable interest and topped the sale at £14,600 after a battle between bidders at the sale and on the telephone, with the latter from Lancashire winning the day. The 1952 Nuffield DM4 made £3,400 and the 1952 Ferguson T20 made £1,200.

Vehicles: Best in the vehicles was £11,400 for a 2011 VW Amarok pickup, the 2007 Suzuki SX4 made £960 and the 1995 Peugeot 205 MGD £300.

Trailers: Top price was £1,600 for an Ifor Williams DP120, the Viking flatbed made £1,375; the Brian James low loader £1,350 and the Marston DS5 £1,300. £210 was made for a box van container and £260 for an old exhibition trailer.

Farm Machinery: A Twose flat roll made £260 and a McConnel 5' topper £230.

Sheep Equipment: In the sheep section a 4 panel race made £380, a WM ironwork turnover crate £260, creeps to £105, cratches to £120, feeders to £100, hurdles to £13.

Miscellaneous: sold to a top of £310 for 6 Fordson wheel weights, £150 for an anvil, £95 for 2 Ferguson front wheel weights and £95 for church pews.
