



## TENBURY 36<sup>th</sup> ANNUAL COLLECTIVE SALE OF STANDING STRAW

**8<sup>th</sup> July 2021**

Nick Champion auctioneer reports a strong trade at the 36<sup>th</sup> annual Tenbury Wells collective auction of 792.25 acres of standing straw which was again held as a roving auction on the farms on 8<sup>th</sup> July 2021.

Most venues attracted a very good turnout of buyers including one active buyer from Lancashire and the best prices were for the heaviest, clean, Blackgrass free and easily accessible crops.

Winter wheat and winter barley sold at a premium with all the better crops selling in excess of £80 to a top of £105 for a field of wheat offered by Derek Small & Sons at Whitton, closely followed at £102 for a field offered by E H Handley & Sons at Rochford.

Winter barley was also well sought after topping at £100 for a field offered by Neil Ward at Eastham.

Oat straw was as usual less in demand but topped at a pleasing £92 for a field offered by Bickley House Farm at Bickley.

Spring barley saw a terrific crop at Sutton achieve £80 from E H Handley & Sons, whilst just one field of winter triticale was on offer and made £75 for J W Williams & Sons, Pensax.

### General prices as follows:

341.25 acres of winter wheat sold from £68 to £105 to average £83.21.

199.5 acres of winter barley sold from £70 to £100 to average £79.95.

98.75 acres of spring barley sold from £35 to £80 to average £47.91.

126.75 acres of winter oat sold from £45 to £92 to average £76.31.

16.25 acres of spring oat sold at £48.

9.75 acres of winter triticale sold at £75.
